

Sudoku means 'single number' in Japanese.

There are six boxes in this sudoku puzzle, each of which contains six small squares.

Your job is to be sure that each box contains every number From 1-6.

But your challenge is to place those numbers into the small squares so that each number appears only once in any row across, or column down.

The numbers which are already in the puzzle will serve as your guide.

Remember, numbers can't be repeated in the 2×3 box, in the 6 small boxes across or the 6 small boxes down. So use the existing numbers to eliminate where other numbers can go.
